

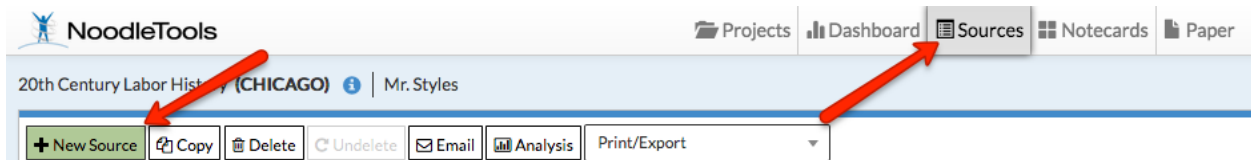


# NoodleTools

## Import an Article

Unlike book citations, which can be directly imported from WorldCat, articles need to be copied into NoodleTools

- Print or in-hand
- Journal

For articles from a database found in HTML format use:

- Database
- Journal
