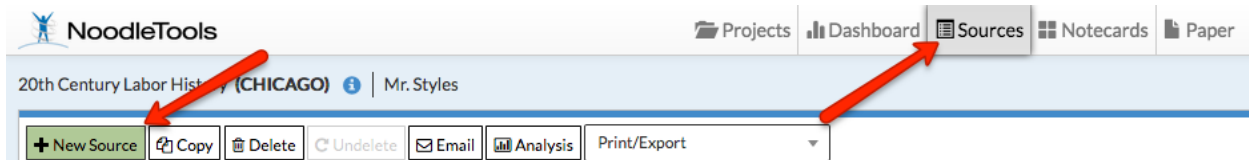




## Import a Newspaper Article
